LUIGI GIUSSANI (1922-2005) WAS AN ITALIAN PRIEST AND EDUCATOR WHO FOUNDED THE CATHOLIC MOVEMENT COMMUNION AND LIBERATION, WHICH IS NOWADAYS PRESENT IN MORE THAN 70 COUNTRIES ALL OVER THE WORLD.

GIOIA PALMIERI

Journalist who founded an educational initiative that offers courses in Italian language and culture to children and adults.

The discussion will be chaired by Rudi Palmieri, who lectures Argumentation and Communication at the University of Liverpool.
